- Schools and students

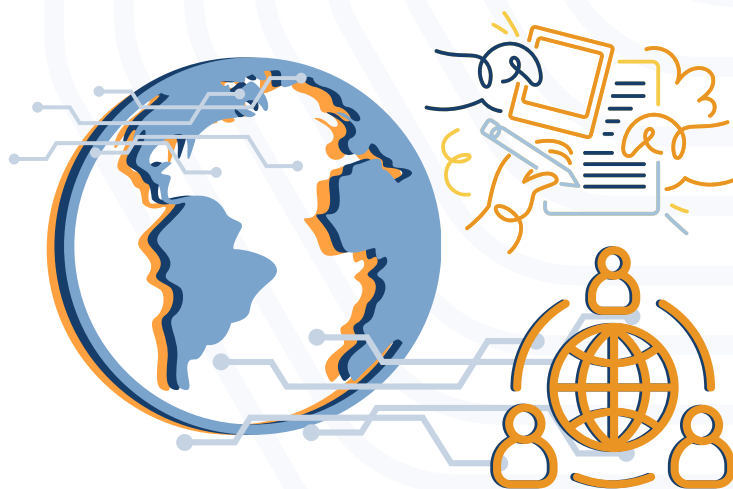
How OLI Partners are Bridging the Gap
